*HEALTH AND SAFETY EXECUTIVE FIGURES UNDER RIDDOR, 12 MONTH INCIDENCE 2013/2014



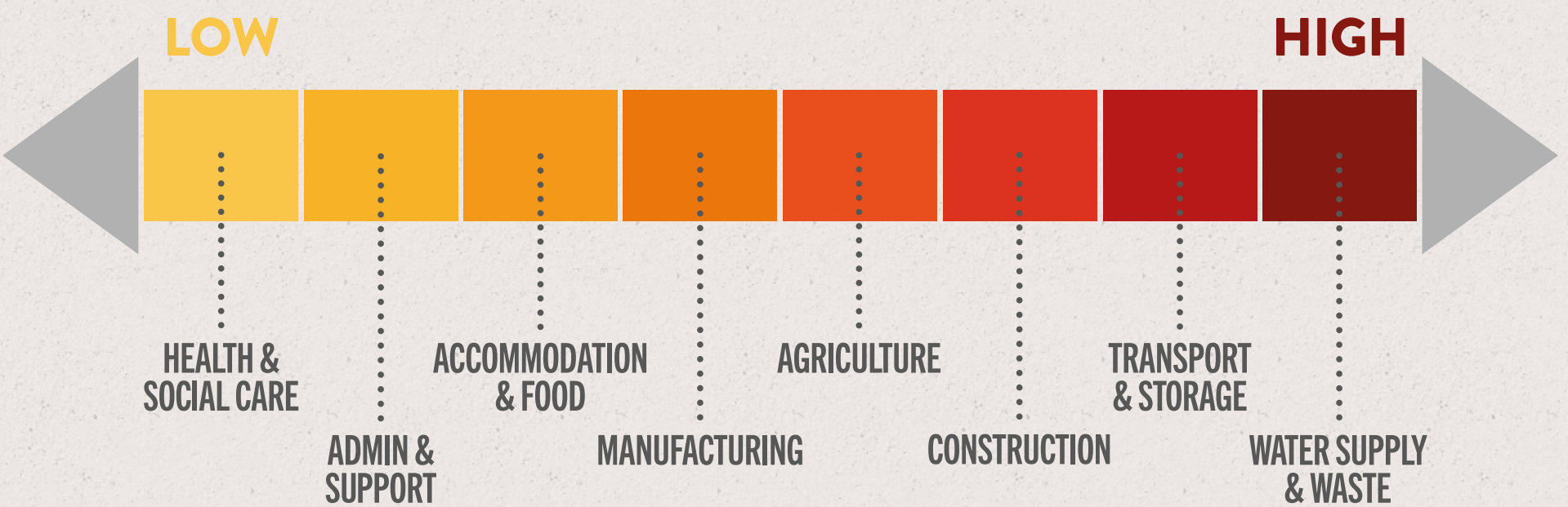
OF THESE ACCIDENTS THE MOST FREQUENTLY FATAL WERE:

An estimated 1.9 million working days were lost due to handling injuries and slip & trip accidents alone. This figure does not include other injuries of varying severity.
